Dear New Mexico Liquor Licensees,

Again, New Mexico has seen a terrible resurgence in COVID-19 cases. The exponential spread of the virus is threatening New Mexico's ICU capacity, front line health workers, and first responders.

Per today's Public Health Order from the New Mexico Department of Health the following restrictions are in effect for the next two weeks (Monday November 16 – Monday November 30):

1. Restaurants may remain open for pickup and delivery of food, but all indoor and outdoor dining is prohibited. All restaurants must close by 10 p.m.
2. Breweries, wineries and distilleries may remain open for take-out package sales only, but must close by 10 p.m.
3. Grocery, convenience, and package liquor stores may remain open at no more than 25% maximum capacity but must minimize operations and in-person staffing to the greatest extent possible. All retail stores must close by 10 p.m.
4. "Close Contact Recreational Facilities" which include bars, nightclubs, event venues, casinos, and private clubs remain closed.
5. "Outdoor Recreational Facilities" which include horse racing tracks, golf courses, and ski basins are closed until November 30, 2020
