RECORD OF SALES & KEG REGISTRATION NOTICE

Please read the following information carefully before signing and dating this form.

NMSA 1978 §60-7A-4.2 “A. It is a violation of the Liquor Control Act for any person licensed pursuant to the provisions of that act and any employee, agent or lessee of that person to fail to **maintain a record of sales** of distilled spirits, wine and beer in quantities of **twenty gallons or more to a single purchaser.**” and,

§60-7B-12 Requires the **registration of kegs of beer containing more than six gallons of beer at the time it is sold** and **any person who purchases** twenty gallons of alcoholic beverage or more, or a keg of beer must read and sign this form.

Sales and Keg Registration forms are regularly inspected by agents of the New Mexico Department of Public Safety’s Special Investigations Unit. This form shall be made available to law enforcement officials upon request.

It is a violation of the Liquor Control Act, and other state laws, for any person to commit any of the following acts:

- To give or serve alcoholic beverage to any person who is obviously intoxicated.
- For a minor (any person under 21 years of age) to possess, procure or to attempt to possess or procure any alcoholic beverage.
- For any person to sell, serve or give any alcoholic beverage to a minor, or to aid or assist a minor in procuring alcoholic beverage (**fourth degree felony**).
- To sell, or offer for sale, or to possess with intent to resale, any alcoholic beverage without a New Mexico Liquor License issued by the NM Regulation and Licensing Department’s Alcohol & Gaming Division (**fourth degree felony**).
- For any licensed establishment to purchase or procure alcoholic beverage from anyone other than a Licensed Wholesaler.
