PUBLIC NOTICE

NEW MEXICO BOARD OF BARBERS AND COSMETOLOGISTS NOTICE REGARDING STUDENT PERMITS

Due to the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency, the Board of Barbers and Cosmetologist has extended the time allotted for student permit holders.

Under the provisions of Rule 16.34.4.14 NMAC, student permits are valid for ninety (90) days following completion of graduation requirements to allow time for students to test.

Professional Credential Services (PCS) has determined it is necessary to postpone upcoming practical examinations in New Mexico due to the public health emergency until further notice. All candidates will be rescheduled on the first available date and notified by PCS via email once a new exam date has been determined.

Student Permits issued on or after February 1, 2020 are valid for ninety (90) days after PCS and PSI testing sites resume their normal testing schedules, or until COVID-19 Health restrictions are lifted, whichever occurs first.

Students are encouraged to check their email accounts for any updates regarding exam and admission notices.

PCS will continue to process applications and documents from remote locations.
