**OFFERING TELEHEALTH AND TELE-
SUPERVISION
DURING THE COVID-19
PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY
IN EXECUTIVE ORDER 2020-004**

Due to the public health emergency declared by Governor Michelle Lujan Grisham in Executive Order 2020-004, individuals licensed under the New Mexico Counseling and Therapy Practice Board (Board) are permitted to provide telehealth services to clients under the New Mexico Telehealth Act, Sections 24-25-1 through 24-25-5, NMSA 1978.

Licensees must comply with all statutory requirements under the Telehealth Act to engage in telehealth services. Licensees must continue to uphold all Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) regulations and ensure their methods of providing telehealth are HIPAA-compliant before commencing telehealth services with clients.

The Board is also allowing for tele-supervision at this time. Supervision must still meet all time and participant limits as defined in Section 8 of 16.27.1 NMAC. Modes of tele-supervision must also be HIPAA-compliant before commencing supervision.
