DEFAULT ORDER

THIS MATTER came before the New Mexico Respiratory Care Advisory Board ("Board") on August 29, 2014, and the Board finds as follows:

- A Notice of Contemplated Action was issued on October 25, 2013, regarding a license application submitted by the Respondent to the Board and received by the Board on February 13, 2012.
- 2. The NCA alleged that Respondent, in his application, disclosed that his license to practice as a respiratory care practitioner in the State of Indiana had been suspended.
- 3. Respondent's actions which resulted in the suspension of his Indiana license constitute unprofessional or unethical conduct and has failed to satisfy the Board of his qualifications to be issued a license by the Board.
- 4. The NCA was served on Respondent in accordance with the Uniform Licensing Act ("ULA"), NMSA 1978, Section 61-1-5 at Respondent's last known address.
- The NCA was delivered by the USPS on October 29, 2013, and signed by the Respondent.
- 6. Respondent did not request a hearing pursuant to the ULA.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that, pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 61-12B-12, the Board is hereby denying the application for a New Mexico respiratory care practitioner license submitted by the Respondent, Paul O. Kindig.

The order is final and not subject to judicial review.
