**NOTICE OF SUSPENSION**

**YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED** that Respondent Alex T. Estrada's Professional Mixed Martial Arts License and Professional Boxer License are hereby suspended effective Monday, November 14, 2016, and shall remain suspended until final adjudication, pursuant to the authority granted the New Mexico Athletic Commission (Commission) in the Professional Athletic Competition Act (Act), NMSA 1978, Section 60-2A-1 to -33 and Commission rules and regulations. See sections 60-2A-14.A (4); 15.6.16.8 and 15.6.16.9 NMAC.

This immediate suspension is necessary to protect the public welfare and interests and is based upon allegations that Respondent violated certain provisions of the Act, in connection with the events held in New Mexico titled "Three Crosses Entertainment Promotions" held on October 17, 2015, in Las Cruces, and "Elite Promotions" held on October 8, 2016, in Las Cruces. More specifically, the Respondent tested positive for THC on October 17, 2015, and October 8, 2016, after submitting to random urinalysis tests at the request of the Commission. The Commission alleges this conduct violated Section 60-2A-14.A (4) and 15.6.15.12.A NMAC by continually testing positive for THC.

**NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN, SHOULD RESPONDENT LIKE THE OPPORTUNITY FOR A FORMAL HEARING ON THIS MATTER, HE MUST**

**RESPOND WITH A WRITTEN REQUEST FOR A HEARING WITHIN TWENTY (20) DAYS OF RECEIPT OF THIS NOTICE.** The request for hearing must be sent to the Commission in writing, by certified return receipt mail to the address below. Failure to respond to this Notice of Suspension will result in the Commission taking further disciplinary action, which will be final. Please send your response to:

The formal hearing, if requested, will be conducted pursuant to the Commission rule 15.6.16.11 NMAC. Respondent is specifically advised as follows:

15.6.16.11 NMAC- RIGHTS OF PERSON ENTITLED TO HEARING. A Respondent entitled to be heard under 15.6.16.11 Athletic Commission provisions has the following rights: They may represent themselves before the Commission or its duly appointed hearing officer; Respondent also has the right to be represented by counsel; present all relevant evidence by means of witnesses and books, papers, documents and other evidence; and to examine all opposing witnesses who appear on any matter relevant to the issues; and to have subpoenas and subpoenas *duces tecum* issued for the attendance of witnesses and the production of relevant books, papers, documents and other evidence upon making written request to the Commission. The issuance of such subpoenas after the commencement of the hearing rests in the discretion of the Commission as outlined in Section 60-2A-15.
