CID/MHD Warns New Mexicans to Be Wary of Unscrupulous Contractors Following Storms

LAS CRUCES, N.M. – The Construction Industries Division (CID) of the Regulation and Licensing Department warns New Mexicans, especially those who live in areas recently affected by hailstorms, to be wary of unlicensed contractors and contractors performing unpermitted work.

“When contracting services after a damaging storm, you need to be cautious not to be taken advantage of by unlicensed or unqualified contractors,” said Construction Industries and Manufactured Housing Division Director Pat McMurray. “Please call our office to check on a contractor’s credentials so we can help protect you from dishonest individuals trying to make a quick buck.”

Recent storms in the Las Cruces area have caused damage to some roofs, manufactured houses, carports, and mobile homes. Before hiring a contractor to complete repairs, please contact the Construction Industries Division to check the contractor’s credentials and to make sure the contractor gets the proper permits.
